2010-2011 Music Selection Information

This information applies to ALL ENSEMBLE PARTICIPANTS

- There will be **two concert performances; a 6:00 and an 8:00 concert performance time**. The student’s concert time will be sent with the registration confirmation letter. Every effort will be made to place family members in the same concert. Some groups may be required to perform in both concerts. **Each title selection will be able to accommodate up to 52 students divided evenly into two groups**, There will be no limit to the number of tickets an individual may purchase.
- Read and follow the guidelines in the Ensemble Teacher and Student Information pages.
- Music Selections are listed by title only, not by group numbers. Teachers are strongly encouraged to study the music before placement. Assign music a grade below the student’s current playing skill. The students should almost sight-read it. A student struggling with technical or musical problems will not enjoy playing in the Ensemble and may disrupt the group.
- Introduce the music to the student immediately after your registration is accepted. If student is not prepared, he/she may be dropped at any point in the rehearsal process at the discretion of the conductor and the Ensemble Committee. The teacher will be notified and is responsible to talk to the student and parents. Students with more than one absence, (unexcused or excused) will be dropped.
- Conduct each student so he/she understands the basic conducting patterns.
- Music lists have been given to the following music stores: Central Music and Music and Arts Center. The Ensemble Committee is not responsible for the availability of music at either store.
