- **Read eligibility requirements on Music Selections page carefully before registering students.**
Students registered in groups for which they are not eligible will not be allowed to perform in that group and will have to move to a different group, even if they have already learned the music.
- After registration is accepted, you will receive confirmation of enrollment that will include rehearsal and concert times. **Read registration database carefully and contact Susan Shiner immediately with acceptance of information or errors. This information is given to the conductors, and is used for the program and certificates so accuracy is very important. Please show the database to your students for accurate spelling.**
- **It is the teacher's responsibility to place all dates and times of concert and rehearsals on the student information form. Place the signed student information form in the student's black notebook before the first rehearsal.** The teacher will be contacted after the first rehearsal if this signed completed form is not in their student's notebook. This applies to adult students and teachers
- The teacher is the liaison between his/her students/parents and the conductor/ensemble committee.
At no time are the committee member's telephone numbers or email addresses to be given to parents.
- Be prepared to help where needed. You will be contacted by the volunteer chairperson after the reading session.
